Entry Requirements Guidelines

Please read carefully and follow the instructions below in order to be eligible to compete in the Alabama State Finals.

COMPLETING THE FORM

- **ALL FORMS MUST BE TYPED.**
- List your name as you wish it to appear on your certificate and in the program.
- NEW: Name and contact information for legal guardian is required.
- Two poems must be submitted for this competition. **One poem must be 25 lines or less.** Number of lines will be computed as fitting on one line across an 8 ½ x 11 page in 12 point type.
- Names of the poems must be listed in the order that you will perform them. Once this form has been submitted, no changes may be made to poem choice, editing or order of performance.
- NEW: Check the box to verify citizenship or permanent residence status.
- Read photography, copyright permission, and verification of originality statement and sign the form.
- Legal guardian must also sign this form if student is under 18 years of age.

ENTRY SUBMISSION **Deadline: December 15th, 2017**

- Complete the entire form as indicated above, including all required signatures.
- Scan the form to a pdf document.
- Create a separate Word or Simple Text document for each poem (**No pdf's or jpegs**); these copies of the student's original poems must be accurate as they are to be performed and verified as original work. **Students are responsible for submitting their own work** to ensure accuracy.
